Rules Regarding Accommodations at Lake Yale Conference Center

1. Lake Yale is an **ALCOHOL** and **SMOKE-FREE** campus.
2. **Lodging** at the conference is in motel-style rooms in one and two-story buildings with either a King-size or two beds and a bath, TV and phone. You may request first floor. Handicap accessible rooms are available by reservation.
3. **Campsites** are available for RVs. Campers and commuters may purchase cafeteria meals. (See registration form.)
4. **Cooking** is allowed in RVs, but not in rooms. Pets are NOT permitted. WiFi is available in the meeting rooms and Fellowship Hall.
5. **Facility Fee** - A fee of **\$10 per day** is charged to all attendees at Lake Yale. It is included in the lodging fee for those staying in the hotels. If you are in an RV, staying off campus, commuting from home, or come just to shop and view the exhibits, you will be charged this fee separately.
6. **Food Service** - Meals are served cafeteria style. Vegetarian and gluten-free diets can be accommodated; please indicate on the Conference Registration Form. Breakfast: 7:30 - 8:30 a.m.; Lunch: 12:00 – 1:00 p.m.; Dinner: 5:30 – 6:30 p.m.
